Being able to harvest your own carrots, have fresh spices for cooking or enjoy a beautiful bouquet of flowers can add a golden edge to everyday life. As a tenant at Skebo, you have the opportunity to grow in pallet collars for private use, in the areas where the conditions allow this.

Skebo's commitment

- Skebo is responsible for the pallet collar itself (in a maximum of two floors), ground cloth and topsoil
- Skebo decides in consultation with the tenant on the location of the pallet collar
- Skebo has the right to decide on the maximum number of pallet collars that can be in an area.
- If Skebo feels that the cultivation is not being managed, the grower must be informed of this. If the maintenance does not improve within two weeks, Skebo has the right to terminate the agreement and remove the pallet collar with immediate effect.

Tenant's commitment:

- To take care of the pallet collar before, during and after the growing season and keep the area around it tidy.
- Agree with the seeds or seedlings that are to be planned in the pallet collar as well as any filling soil and fertilizer.
- Agrees with the tools needed to take care of the cultivation.
- Not growing bulky things like trees or bushes in the pallet collar
- Growing in an environmentally friendly way without chemical herbicides
